4. Questions are written in English. You must answer in the best possible ASL format using vocabulary that makes sense. (Do not simply answer with a 'yes' or 'no')
5. Complete video must be no less than three minutes and no more than five minutes. Assessor will comment on the first five minutes only if time is exceeded.
6. Comments will be sent to the email address (or addresses) indicated in the above profile submitted.

1. \*What is your name?
2. Answer this question: Did you enjoy practicing ASL?
3. Answer this question: Where do you want to eat?
4. Sign: "I'm bored, Let's go"
5. Sign: "When you have finished signing ASL, what do you want to do?"
6. Show how the sign "HELP" can be used.
7. Answer this question: "Why are you tired?"
8. Answer the question: "Did you enjoy the movie?"
9. Sign: "I am going to the library"
10. Sign: "Goodbye, see you later"
11. If you are under 3 minutes, add several of your own ASL sentences including at least one sentence with the fingerspelled name of a city, or person.

\*Required first.

Answer as many other questions (your choice: remember to sign "question#\_\_") within 5 minutes or less.
