1. *What is your name?
2. Sign: "You sign so clearly. I can't imagine signing like you."
3. Answer the Question: "Do you want to interpret?"
4. Answer the Question: "What would you like to do when you graduate?"
5. Sign: "Is your brother a mechanic or an accountant?"
6. Answer the Question: "What would you like to eat for lunch?"
7. Sign: "I like to eat cheeseburgers and French fries even though they are not good for me."
8. Answer the Question: "Who is your favorite actor and the character he/she played?"
9. Sign: "My daughter will be 23 next week. Her name is Jenny and she is an Interpreter"
10. Sign: " I lost my hat and gloves yesterday. Can you help me find them before we go?"
11. Answer the Question: " Why do you like to go to the Mall?"
12. " I have to go home in 4 hours. Do you want to shop for another hour before lunch?"
13. If you are under 3 minutes, add several of your own ASL sentences including at least one sentence with the fingerspelled name of a city, or person.
